Dear Chairwoman DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting funding for safety and mobility improvements at a congested intersection located on U.S. Highway 287 in Fort Collins, CO in fiscal year 2023.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Fort Collins. The project will be located at the intersection of College Avenue (U.S. 287) and Trilby Road in Fort Collins, CO 80525. The funding would be used to create additional turning lanes, new sidewalks, enhanced bus stops, American Disability Act (ADA) compliant ramps, and raised medians to improve safety for all users of the road. This project will reduce the most common and most severe types of crashes (i.e., rear-end, broadside, and right-angle) by reducing congestion, constructing auxiliary turn lanes and new traffic signals, and using protected-only left-turn phasing.
