I am requesting funding for the Estes Park Stanley Park Complex in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Estes Park located at 170 MacGregor Ave, Estes Park, CO 80517. The funding would be used to replace 30,000 square feet of deteriorating stall barns at the Stanley Park Complex. These structures, built nearly 80 years ago, have reached the end of their functional life and currently hinder the town's ability to support the regional livestock and agricultural sectors.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this complex provides the essential infrastructure required for livestock commerce and youth developmental programs which are vital to the economic health of Larimer County and the surrounding rural communities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
